# Information for Parents



Play Ranger sessions are open access free play opportunities for children aged 8 - 12 years, provided in local parks. We have lots of ideas, equipment and games for children to take part in.

We welcome children of school age who are under the age of 8 years, if they are accompanied at all times by a parent or responsible adult.

We offer play opportunities in such a way that the participants can only be supervised whilst on site and participating in our activities. We cannot be responsible for your child out of session hours, nor can participants be confined to the park or prevented from coming and going as they please. We are not providing child care, and we are not able to escort participants home.

All sessions will be run by qualified play rangers and are **FREE OF CHARGE**

In the event of unforeseen circumstances (bad weather – unsafe conditions etc) a session may be cancelled or stopped at short notice.

Our Service aims to be friendly, safe and fun so that the participants can take part in the activities regardless of race, gender, religion, cultural background, or physical ability.

This project has been funded by the BIG Lottery, and as part of our reporting back system, we need to provide evidence of the positive benefits of the sessions, therefore we will be taking photographs, with the children's permission to include in reports and documents.
